The making of decisions is regarded as an integral of the lives of the individuals. They are required to make wise and productive decisions in terms of various factors, i.e. education, careers, employment opportunities, family, relationships, settlement, assets, property, resources, travelling and so forth. In putting into operation, decision-making processes, analysis needs to be conducted in terms of various types of alternatives and options that are available. After the analysis is conducted, selection is made of the most worthwhile and favorable alternative or option. On the other hand, the up-gradation of critical-thinking skills is facilitating in putting into operation, rational, logical and methodological thinking. Hence, up-gradation of analytical and critical-thinking skills is facilitating in putting into operation decision-making processes in a well-ordered manner. As a consequence, individuals will render an important contribution in providing solutions to social and interpersonal problems. When individuals will be satisfied, they will communicate with their family and community members in an effective manner. Therefore, making wise and productive decisions is a notable measure to be put into operation in providing solutions to social and interpersonal problems.

Conclusion

Social and interpersonal problems are impediments in socializing with family and community members. Effects of social and interpersonal problems are, problems in achieving educational goals; impediments in implementation of job duties within employment settings; experiencing loneliness; being overwhelmed by psychological problems; problems in forming an effective social circle and barriers in leading to up-gradation of competencies and abilities. Individuals need to be well-informed regarding measures to be put into operation in providing solutions to social and interpersonal problems. Finally, it can be stated, solving social and interpersonal problems is facilitating in leading to progression of individuals.

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
